



# ECONOMICS OF URBAN FORESTRY IN NORTH DAKOTA

Trees have a tremendous impact on local economies and our quality-of-life. **Here's a peek at how urban trees in your state are contributing.**



**706** people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in North Dakota.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$67.6 million** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.



Communities in North Dakota enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an average of **\$13.01 per resident** for tree planting and care compared to **\$3.00 per resident** in non-participating communities nationally.



The urban forestry sector in North Dakota has an annual sales and employment footprint worth **\$90.0 million**.



Tree cover at private homes adds **\$6 million** annually to property values across North Dakota.
